Bishop da Cunha has issued a decree which suppresses (closes) the parishes of St. Joseph-St. Therese, Our Lady of Fatima, and St. Mary's. The decree also establishes our new Parish under the name of St. Gabriel the Archangel. Fr. Sudhir and Fr. John will continue as copastors of the new parish. The decree becomes effective on October 11, 2021.

The full text of the decree will be published on our website which continues to be ccnbn.org at this time and on the Diocesan website as

well.

Fr. Sudhir and Fr. John are grateful to the Bishop for this decree and we also want to thank the members of our Core Council for their efforts in working towards our vision of a new community of faith. We wish to acknowledge the leadership offered from the Diocesan Office of Strategic and Pastoral Planning.

Bishop da Cunha will join us on the weekend of October 9-10, 2021 to celebrate our transition from three parishes to one. Further details will be forthcoming. Please continue to pray for our Bishop, and our new faith community of St. Gabriel the Archangel. May the Holy Spirit continue to guides us and strengthen us on our journey of faith.



Classes begin on September 19th. Have you registered yet?

Access the online registration portal through our website – www.ccnbn.org (the link is right on the homepage), use your debit or credit card for payment and you'll be good to go. If you wish to pay by check or cash, a form is available on the website to download and once it's filled out you can return it with payment to the Central Offices.

We will also be having an in person registration weekend for those paying by cash or check. This weekend, September 4th and 5th, we will be outside the church after each mass to give you an opportunity to register and ask questions.

Remember – if your child/teen attends a Catholic school and wishes to begin preparation for the Sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation, they need to complete TWO YEARS of preparation in the Collaborative outside of their religious studies in school according to diocesan requirements. The traditional years to begin this process are in Grades 1 & 8 so please be aware of this before you complete the form.

Still looking for catechists to help in grades 6 & 7. If you or someone you know can volunteer to share the faith with these preteens then please contact faithformation@ccnbn.org and we'll be happy to meet with you to share specifics and get you started.


